



## APPLICATION CLEAN AGENT FIRE EXTINGUISHING SYSTEM

Application is hereby made for the installation of a clean agent suppression system. It is understood that prior to installation beginning, approval for the system is contingent on the installer meeting NFPA 2001, Clean Agent Fire Extinguishing Systems and NFPA 1, Uniform Fire Code most recent editions as approved by NH State Fire Code.

This application must be forwarded to the Fire Prevention Division and submitted with a complete set of plans. "Complete" means plans shall be accompanied by a letter from the designer that the plans meet all requirements as required by code. Plans shall include complete information regarding the system or system alteration including specifications, calculations, cut sheets, wiring diagram, piping diagram and floor plans. Prior to the issuance of the permit, the fire official shall review plans and specifications and may contact you to schedule a pre-installation meeting.

## Work shall not begin until a permit has been issued. All inspection requests require a minimum of a 2-day notice.

Puff tests or other operational tests may be required depending on system type. See your permit for additional information.
