



APPLICATION FOR INSTALLATION OF A LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS STORAGE TANKS AND EXTERNAL PIPING

A permit is required for the installation of an LPG container exceeding 30 gallons individual water capacity or combined containers exceeding 60 gallons water capacity. This permit also covers external piping for LP and NG. Application must be returned with the following information to obtain a permit to install:

- [] a. Site plan showing building(s), lot lines and tank location. This plan can be hand drawn.
- [] b. Indicate piping/regulator locations and type of piping.
- [] c. Indicate measurements from windows, ignition sources, and ventilation devices.
- [] e. Indicate the size (WC) and type (ASME/DOT) of tank(s).

Installation shall comply with NFPA 1, NFPA 54 and NFPA 58, most recent editions as adopted by and modified by the State of NH fire codes.

Underground installations shall be allowed to submit pictures showing four sides of tank in hole (looking for paint scrapes), spoil pile, anode bag and wire, and piping location. Pics must be submitted by email or mail within 5 days of install. Failure to submit pictures will require uncovering the tank for visual inspection for the Fire Official.

THIS IS NOT A PERMIT

No work shall begin until a permit has been issued. All inspection requests require 2-day minimum notice by installer.

The signature below is stating that the contractor agrees to the minimum requirements for this installation.

Permit fee is \$25.00 for a system made payable to the "Town of Kensington, NH".
