<u>Minutes:</u> The minutes from the September 27 meeting were reviewed. Elaine Kaczmarek made the motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Frank Whittemore. Approved unanimously.

<u>PlanNH Charette/Town Center</u>: The American Planning Association (Northern New England Branch) is hosting a conference in Newcastle (Nov. 6-8) and representatives from Kensington are invited to attend to be a part of the panel on the PlanNH Charette process. Lynne and Joni will attend and describe the Town's experience with the Charette, and what has transpired since that time.
